The BSC is home to the Burlington Bayhawks and is proud of its competitive team successes over the years, which includes 44 provincial championships and 13 national championships. The Club holds a Canadian National License, Ontario Provincial Development League (OPDL) License, and League 1 Ontario (L1O) Franchise.

POSITION SUMMARY

As part of the Technical team, the candidate will provide leadership and oversee the development of players to ensure it is aligned with the Club's Mission and Vision. The position manages all aspects of the competitive program, including (but not limited to) games, practices, off-field activities, and program/season planning and curriculum.

The role requires a dedicated person who is passionate about the game and learning. Mentorship and training will be provided and BSC is proud to support its coaches in their coach development/education goals.

- Travel with the team and attend all training sessions and development
- Support the development of styles of play for BSC Competitive teams

Administration

- Prepare player evaluations (two per season)
- Oversee TeamSnap
- Communicate with parents and the wider membership
- Liaise between the club and team

Coach Education and Personal Development

- Attend coach education and development sessions
- Work with Technical team and Manager to create personal development plan and checkpoints
