PLAYING INFORMATION

- Maximum Game Day Roster: 10/12 – 5v5 / 7v7 including a goalkeeper
- Open Rosters - player movement will occur based on performance, attendance, etc.
- 3 training sessions per week plus
 - Participation in PHSA League (Winter)
 - Participation in Peel Halton Festivals (Summer)
- Specialized goalkeeper training (once per week - Winter)

REGISTRATION & FEES

Registration is completed through your PowerUp Sports account and program registration is not completed until the first deposit (due on signing) is paid. Members are welcome to pay with Visa, MasterCard, or AMEX (online/in-person) or debit/cash in office. Registration fees can be paid upfront or via installment.

Applicants are eligible for up to \$300 annually.	CT Jumpstart is a community based charity grant to assist children in financial need participate in sport. There are two application windows – Jan – June; July – November – a maximum of \$300 per child can be issued.	KidSport, through both its local chapters and Provincial organization, provides grants to children facing financial barriers so they can participate in sport. Applicants are eligible to receive up to \$250 per annum towards sport & recreation for their child.
